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Purpose

As discussed with the Minister of Immigration on 3 February 2020, a paper is attached which seeks agreement to a regulation change to enable Immigration New Zealand to require carriers to seek information from intending travellers before embarkation. This minor regulatory amendment implements part of the Immigration response to the current coronavirus (2019-nCoV) situation.

The agreement of Ministers with Power to Act is sought to the regulation change. If those Ministers agree to the change, the regulation will be considered by Executive Council today.

Recommended action

The Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment (the Ministry) recommends that you:

Minister of Immigration:

a **Agree** to require carriers to provide to the Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment information about every person who intends to board a craft, and who has been in a place of concern within the 14-day period before checking in, before boarding that person, to manage the risk of spread of 2019-nCoV;

b **Note** that, on 1 February 2020, Cabinet authorised a group of Ministers, comprising the Prime Minister, the Minister of Foreign Affairs, Minister of Tourism, Minister of Finance, Minister of Education, Minister of Health and Minister for Trade and Export Growth to have Power to Act to take decisions on New Zealand's response to the novel coronavirus outbreak and proposed enhanced border measures [CAB-20-MIN-0015];
