

Health Act (COVID-19 Alert Level 3) Amendment Order (No 2) 2020

Pursuant to section 70(1)(f) and (m) of the Health Act 1956, for the purpose of preventing the outbreak or spread of COVID-19, an infectious disease, Dr Ashley Bloomfield, Director-General of Health, exercising the functions of a Medical Officer of Health for all districts of New Zealand (that is, nationally), in circumstances where a state of emergency has been declared under the Civil Defence Emergency Management Act 2002 and there is an epidemic notice in force, makes the following order.

1 Title

This order is the Health Act (COVID-19 Alert Level 3) Amendment Order (No 2) 2020.

2 Commencement

This order comes into force on 10 May 2020.

3 Principal order

This order amends the Health Act (COVID-19 Alert Level 3) Order 2020 (the **principal order**).

4 Schedule 2 amended

In Schedule 2, Part 2, after item 4, insert:

5 Licensing trusts.

6 Hardware and DIY stores, but only for the purpose of sale to trade customers.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on 10 May 2020, amends the Health Act (COVID-19 Alert Level 3) Order 2020. The list of category B businesses in Part 2 of Schedule 2 of that order is amended by adding the following businesses:

- licensing trusts, to permit them to have customers in their premises; and
- hardware and DIY stores, to permit them to have customers in their premises (but only for the purpose of sale to trade customers).
